FORCED DISPLACEMENT DUE TO ARMED CONFLICT

COLOMBIA 2024



During 2024 at least 338.412 people were displaced as a consequence of the armed conflict.



This number corresponds to 2.29% of the population aged 15+ with internet access in Colombia.

The number of internally displaced people -IDPs- in 2024 is **15% higher** than in **2023**



47% of those displaced reported leaving together with 10 or more households, suggesting there were mass displacement events

Causes of displacement

58% of IDPs left as a consequence of Non State **Armed Groups** or their clashes; 18% did so because of gangs; 22% due to threats or fear of violence.



68% of the displaced received **no assistance** from government, NGOs, or friends/ family.

The main needs reported by IDPs are housing, utilities, employment and food.
